services, beginning January 1, 2019 the State mandated that local agencies collect an additional \$4.00 fee for business licenses. Of the portion of the State mandated fees collected, 10% is remitted to the State, up to 5% is retained by the City for administrative overhead, and 85% is for program services. If the State adopts a change in this fee, the City Manager is authorized and directed to collect the fee mandated by the State.
